MAKING OUR SCHOOL SAFE

- Expectations/Requirements
 - Everyone will be required to wear a mask.
 - Everyone will have their temperature checked upon entering the building.
 - Nobody will be allowed to enter the building except staff and students.
 - Sanitation Stations will be setup in every classroom.

- Expectation in the Classroom
 - Students will receive their own set of supplies
 - Partitions will be installed for each student
 - Teachers will have thermometers
 - Students will be required to maintain social distance



MAKING OUR SCHOOL SAFE

- Expectations from Parents
 - Have your child practice wearing a mask.
 - Do not send your child to school who has a temperature of 100.4° F or displaying any signs of being sick.
 - Parents are required to email the office manager and principal to notify them of their child's illness and subsequent absence.
 - Make sure that the school has your updated phone number and email address.
- Closing Campus to Visitors
 - In order to mitigate the risk of possible exposure and spread of COVID-19, Monroe Charter Academy will be closed to all visitors, including parents.
 - When parents arrive to campus to drop off their child for late arrival or pick up their child early, they will stay in their vehicle and call the main office. We will bring your child to your vehicle.

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MAKING OUR SCHOOL SAFE

- Student/Staff Exhibit Symptoms
 - Students and their siblings will be isolated from others and monitored until picked up. They will be required to be tested.
 - Staff will be sent home and required to be tested.
 - The school will be closed for the remainder of the quarantine period, or possibly longer.
